



Injector Transition-to-Practice Mentorship Program

Total Investment: \$10,000

Format:

- Hybrid Online and In-Person
- 2:1 Mentorship – Maximum 2 students/per session
- 12 Mentored Clinical Practice Days

Schedule: Exact dates determined collaboratively between student and instructor


PROGRAM COMPONENTS

Phase 1 – Online Foundational Learning (Pre-Requisite)

Completed prior to in-person training through Beauty Xpressions Academy.

Includes access to the following courses:

- Facial Anatomy for Aesthetic Injections
- Cosmetic Neuromodulator Injections for Nurses (Basic & Advanced)
- Hyaluronic Acid Dermal Fillers for Nurses (Basic & Advanced)
- Cosmetic PRP for the Nurse Injector
- Fundamentals of Skin Boosters
- Microneedling & Mesotherapy Fundamentals
- Poly-L-Lactic Acid (Sculptra) Biostimulators
- Medical Aesthetics Entrepreneurship

 These courses establish a shared theoretical foundation, ensuring in-person mentorship time is spent on **clinical application**, not introductory theory.

Phase 2 – Week One: Foundations & Consultation (5 Days)

Day 1 – In-Person Classroom

- Comprehensive facial assessment
- Health assessment and contraindications review
- Patient psychology & expectation management
- Ethical treatment planning
- Multi-session and combination therapy planning
- Documentation, consent, and scope considerations
- Marketing and Advertising guidelines
- Starting up your practice as an entrepreneur, independent contractor, or employee

Days 2–5 – Mentored Clinical Practice

- ***Neuromodulators*** (foundational cosmetic indications)
- Introductory ***dermal filler*** techniques
- ***Platelet-rich plasma, microneedling and skin boosters***
- Aseptic technique, positioning, pacing
- Managing complications, near-misses, and revisions
- Observation → assisted injection → supervised injection
- Daily pre-clinic teaching & post-clinic debriefs

Phase 3 – Week Two: Integration & Skill Expansion (4 Days)

(Scheduled approximately 1 month later **or as mutually agreed**)

- Facial balancing concepts
- Cannula refinement and safety principles
- Product selection and treatment sequencing
- Refinement of consultation and assessment skills
- Increasing autonomy under supervision

- **Biostimulators** indications and planning, hands-on practice

Phase 4 – Week Three: Advanced Application & Clinical Judgment (4 Days)

(Scheduled approximately 1 month later or as mutually agreed)

- **Advanced dermal filler** cannula and needle techniques
 - **Advanced and medical neuromodulator** treatments
 - Combination treatments and long-term patient strategies
 - Workflow efficiency, charting, and professionalism
 - Transitioning into independent or supervised practice

Bonus Experience - Prolenium Revanesse Facility Field Trip

- Educational Factory Tour and Hands-On Dermal Filler Practice Day with PACE Academy Trainers
 - Group event – multiple injectors
 - If desired, student may sign up to receive dermal filler treatments by their other colleagues that are attending – treatments are at no cost.
 - Sessions are scheduled throughout the year
 - The student may schedule this experience at any point within 1 year of enrollment as their schedule allows; however, it is recommended to have at least Phase 1 and 2 completed before attending.
